

Dear colleagues,

I would like to ask you to announce new topics for the so-called "final projects" and master theses, in sufficient numbers to give students a choice. Writing out a sufficient number of topics for the students and keeping a sufficient number of student theses is a parameter that is already taken into account in the evaluation of EVAK staff. It is expected of male and female academic staff. The decision on which non-academic staff can or even should write topics is made by their supervisor (research group leader). In all cases, it is advisable to consult the research group leader about the intention to write a thesis and the topic under consideration.

RECETOX management expects each research group to write a minimum of 1-2 final project topics and a minimum of 1-2 thesis topics each year. This parameter will be part of the EVAK evaluation of individual staff members and the evaluation of research group leaders.

Final projects (for reference, I attach a draft of the forthcoming faculty description of what a final project is)

6 students are entering their third year of BC study in the Environment and Health (E&H) plan and 9 students are in the Environmental Health (EH) specialization. Before listing topics, please remind yourself of the goals and focus of the BC Environment and Health curriculum (<https://is.muni.cz/auth/program/24088/zivotni-prostredi-a-zdravi>). Decide whether your topic is more appropriate for the ZPAZ curriculum (<https://is.muni.cz/auth/plan/24089/zivotni-prostredi-a-zdravi>) or the EZ specialization (<https://is.muni.cz/auth/plan/26844/environmentalni-zdravi>). List the topic in the appropriate topic schedule.
